Since our year started in June, Assisteens have held a successful food drive for Families Forward, worked to clean up CdM State Beach twice, put together towel sets for Human Options, sewn approximately 600 cloth face masks for OSB, packed school supplies kits and purchased hygiene kits for OSB, put together senior citizen care packages, donated \$2000 of Albertson's gift cards to IVC students in need, sewn baby layettes for Kaiser Permanente Hospital, created Halloween goodie bags for HomeAid OC, bought food to fill Thanksgiving food baskets for Families Forward, put together holiday goodie bags and donated gift cards for Ronald McDonald House, made wreaths and holiday cards for assisted living residents, took part in Families Forward Adopt a Family, wrapped toys for Marine family children, and created festive holiday packs filled with hats, gloves, and candy for HomeAid OC. That is a lot of benevolent giving in six months during a pandemic!

Congratulations to you all for your commitment and enthusiasm. You sold over \$13,000 of See's Candy, netting \$6,424. We brought in 13 new members and have conducted successful Governing Body and General meetings through zoom.

In the new year, Assisteens will continue to serve our community by finding more creative ways to help out those in need. With Valentine's Day coming up, watch your email for goodie bag signups.
