

Assisteens® An auxiliary of Assistance League® of Irvine Membership Obligations

As with any organization, there are guidelines and commitments required of our members. Following is a summary of the Assisteens membership obligations:

HOURS

- Members must serve 30 hours each year, 15 of which must be served on philanthropic service projects. Participation in meetings and organized social events will count toward the 15 non-philanthropic hours.
- Parents must serve 10 hours each year in support of Assisteens. Participation in parent meetings and in philanthropic service projects as parent volunteer, and time spent on transporting Assisteens to events will count towards the 10 hours.
- Parents of Committee Chairmen are expected to attend and assist at the volunteer events hosted by the Chairman.
- Parents are encouraged to work 3 shifts each year in the Assistance League of Irvine (ALI) Thrift Shop.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

- Annual Dues:
 - New Members \$200 / Active Members \$150
- Socials (optional) \$10-\$25 a few times per year
- Annual Dinner (optional) \$20 \$25 for each teen and parent
- Participate in and support our fundraising events during the year (See's Candies, recycle, restaurant fundraising)

MEETINGS

- Attend all regularly scheduled General and Class Meetings on the third Wednesday of June, September, November, January, March and April. Meetings are held at Venado Middle School at 7pm and generally last 1 to 1 ¹/₂ hours depending on the agenda. You may have 3 excused absences per year.
- Attend Class Meetings only in October and February. The Advisors of each class determine the content, time and location of these two meetings.
- September and March are Mandatory Parent Meetings and the meetings are held after the scheduled General Meetings in those two months.
